- ❖ An inclusive interim budget covering all constituents of the society including farmers, youth, women, deprived classes.
- ❖ Vote on account for expenditure for first four months of the financial year 2019-20.
- ❖ Provision of additional Rs. 2,000 Crore from contingency fund for drought relief measures.
- ❖ Rs. 8,733 Crore outlay for irrigation projects. Special attention on Vidarbha, Marathwada and DPAP area.
- ❖ Provision of Rs. 1,500 Crore for Jalyukta Shivar Abhiyan.
- ❖ Provision of Rs. 5,187 Crore for micro irrigation, wells and farm ponds along with Employment Guarantee Scheme Department.
- ❖ Rs. 3,498 Crore for various schemes of Agriculture Department.
- ❖ Rs. 900 Crore for electric connections to agricultural pumpsets.
- ❖ Rs. 572 Crore outlay under Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Scholarship Scheme for students in economically weaker class.
- ❖ Rs. 8,500 Crore outlay for road development in the State.
- ❖ Provision of Rs. 1,105 Crore under Central Road Fund Scheme and Rs. 350 Crore for NABARD assisted road development scheme.
- ❖ Rs. 3,700 Crore outlay for development of roads under Hybrid Annuity Model.
- ❖ Rs. 2,164 Crore outlay under Chief Minister Gram Sadak Yojana.
- ❖ Approval to Rs. 250 Crore for modernization of bus stations of State Road Transport Corporation and outlay of Rs. 101 Crore for this purpose for the year 2019-20.
- ❖ Rs. 6,306 Crore outlay for infrastructure facilities and other works of Energy Department.
- ❖ Rs. 5,210 Crore outlay for concessions in electricity tariff to Agricultural consumers.
- ❖ Rs. 2,400 Crore outlay for Smart Cities and Amrut Mission.

- ❖ Rs. 1,021 Crore Outlay for Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana and Mahatma Phule Jan Arogya Yojana.
- ❖ Rs. 2,098 Crore outlay for National Health Mission.
- ❖ Rs. 9,208 Crore outlay for school, health services, Ramai Gharkul, hostel, resident school etc. under Scheduled Caste Sub Plan.
- ❖ Rs. 2,892 Crore outlay proposed for vimukta jati, nomadic tribes, other backward class and special backward class.
- ❖ Rs. 8,431 Crore Outlay for various schemes of Tribal Development Department.
- ❖ Rs. 465 Crore Outlay has been proposed for various schemes of Minorities Department.
- ❖ Rs. 2,921 Crore outlay for various schemes of Women and Child Development Department.
- ❖ Rs. 6,895 Crore outlay proposed for Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban).
- ❖ For providing nutritious food to children between the age group of 6 months to 3 years, pregnant and lactating mothers, outlay of Rs. 1,097 Crore has been proposed.
- ❖ For providing rice and wheat at a concessional rate of Rs. 2 and 3 respectively to the farmers above poverty line in 14 districts of Marathwada and Vidarbha region, outlay of Rs. 896 Crore has been proposed.
- ❖ Rs. 75 Crore Outlay proposed for Hon. Balasaheb Thackeray Smruti Matoshri Grampanchayat Bandhani Yojana.
- ❖ For construction of quarters for judges and court buildings at various places in the State, outlay of Rs. 725 Crore has been proposed.
- ❖ For police housing, outlay of Rs. 375 Crore has been proposed.
- ❖ For the year 2019-20, size of scheme expenditure is Rs. 99,000 Crore, of which Rs. 9000 Crore for District Plan Schemes.
- ❖ For the year 2019-20, estimated revenue receipts Rs. 3,14,489 Crore.
- ❖ For the year 2019-20, estimated revenue expenditure Rs. 3,34,273 Crore.
- ❖ For the year 2019-20, estimated revenue deficit Rs. 19,784 Crore.
- ❖ In the financial year 2017-18, even though Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Shetkari Sanman Yojana, which was not included in the original budget, was implemented, the State was revenue surplus by Rs. 2,082 Crore.
